At the conclusion of their lively lunch, District 2 members were officially welcomed by Director Angela Davis, who then called the meeting to order.

Approval of Minutes: Angela passed around copies of the minutes from the last District 2 meeting held on December 9, 2014, at Beaufort County Community College. Cathy Campbell made the motion to approve the minutes as presented; the motion carried.

Election of New Officers: Vice-Director Sally Goodman was announced as the new District 2 Director. Maria Fesz was nominated by Garrison Libby for the position of Secretary; with no further nominations Maria was elected by unanimous vote. Cathy Campbell expressed her willingness to remain in the position of CCCLA representative; this was approved by acclimation. Incumbent Garrison, who had been drafted into the CCLINC position when a mid-term vacancy occurred, respectfully declined the opportunity to run against her for the position. Susan was approved by acclimation as the new CCLINC representative.
