















































Open Library NC

- Libraries contribute books to the Lending Collection, to be scanned by Internet Archive
- Internet Archive gets more books to scan and more users to borrow
- NC LIVE member libraries get access to a collection for downloadable eBooks for FREE
- Our goal is at least one book from every member library contributed by December 2012

What We Are Asking Libraries to Do:

- Contribute from 1 up to 10 books
 - o © 1924-1999
 - Books patrons won't miss is physical form
 - Other selection criteria completely up to the library
 - Duplicates, and donation books welcome
- Books scanned and added to the Open Library Lending Collection, with attribution to the library


