
Developing a Research Question

Knowledge Practice: Determine an appropriate scope of investigation

Disposition: Consider research as open-ended exploration and engagement with information


Standard failures:

- 1. Too broad
- 2. Closed ended
- 3. Vague
- 4. Biased perspective/based on logical fallacy
- 5. Too narrow
- 6. Misunderstood question

Keyword Choice


Knowledge Practices:

- Utilize divergent (e.g., brainstorming) and convergent (e.g., selecting the best source) thinking when searching
- Use different types of searching language (e.g., controlled vocabulary, keywords, natural language) appropriately
- Match information needs and search strategies to appropriate search tools

Disposition: Exhibit mental flexibility and creativity

Standard failures:

- 1. Did not develop multiple keywords for main concepts
- 2. Developed unrelated keywords for a single concept
- 3. Repeated terms for different main concepts
- 4. Used non-scholarly/significant natural language
- 5. Left out search terms for a main concept from research question
- 6. Used stop words



Boolean Operators

Knowledge Practices:


- Use different types of searching language (e.g., controlled vocabulary, keywords, natural language) appropriately

Disposition: Exhibit mental flexibility and creativity

Standard failures:

- 1. Incorrect capitalization
- 2. Missing operators
- 3. Incorrect quote marks
- 4. Incorrect parentheses
- 5. Incorrect use of OR


Content Types

Knowledge Practice: Assess the fit between an information product's creation process and a particular information need

- Realize that information sources vary greatly in content and format and have varying relevance and value
- Maintain an open mind and a critical stance
