

Asthma: Management in Older Adults

What We Know

- > Asthma is a chronic disease characterized by reversible airway inflammation and the obstruction of airflow due to transient narrowing of the airways, most often as a result of the body's immunologic response to allergens or irritants and, in older adults as a result of physiologic respiratory changes. (6) Although asthma is commonly referred to as a childhood disease, it is now recognized that the prevalence of asthma in older adults (i.e., individuals > 65 years of age) is higher than previously reported. The exact number of older adults in the United States who have asthma is not known due to underdiagnosis and misdiagnosis, low recognition and underreporting of asthma-related symptoms by the patient, and limited research studies involving older adults with asthma. Results of studies show that asthma in older adults is associated with high rates of hospitalization and substantial healthcare costs, and more than 50% of all asthma-related deaths involve persons with asthma who are 65 years of age and older. In the U.S., patients who are 65 years of age and older represent the 2nd highest age group for all age groups of patients who are hospitalized for asthma, and rank only slightly lower than hospitalized patients with asthma who are 15 years of age and younger. The rate of hospitalizations for older adults is 237 per 100,000, and the average length of hospital stay for this population is 4.5 days(1,3,4,8,10,11,13,15,16)
- In high-income countries, up to 10% of older adults have asthma, including more than
 1 million older adults in the U.S. Asthma in older adults may be the result of persistent
 childhood asthma that worsens (referred to as long-standing asthma [LSA]) or the
 result of intermittent asthma during childhood that reemerges later in life (referred to as
 late-onset asthma [LOA])^(Z-LL)
- -LSA is often due to an allergen sensitization, or trigger exposure, and can begin in childhood or early adulthood and gradually become more severe^(2,11)
- -LOA manifests as persistent wheezing following a viral or bacterial upper respiratory tract infection in persons over 40 years of age. LOA can also develop following occupational exposure (e.g., to aerosol chemicals) and as a result of intolerance to aspirin or NSAIDs⁽¹¹⁾
- Older adults who develop asthma, including those with no history of asthma or other respiratory disease, usually experience symptoms that are more severe than symptoms in younger persons, yet their asthma is frequently misdiagnosed or not diagnosed; this is particularly the case in older adults who smoke. As many as 50% of older adults with asthma either smoke or use to smoke eigarettes, and oral steroid treatment is less effective during acute exacerbations in older adults with asthma who smoke than in nonsmokers or persons who have quit smoking (1.3.5.7.8.11.13.15.17)
- Signs and symptoms that develop in older adults are not specific to asthma and can be more severe due to age-related anatomic and physiologic deterioration, including (8,10,11)
- less elastic airways, which lead to increased trapped air and increased bronchoconstriction (5.11)
- —decreased strength of respiratory muscles⁽⁵⁾
- a decrease in antioxidant defenses, potentially causing older patients to be more susceptible to the asthma-promoting effects of air pollutants⁽⁸⁾

SAMPLE SEARCHES

Once you are ready to search, you can start by either entering the search term in the search box or using various browsing options at the top of the page. Reports can be browsed by:

- · Topic-roughly 30 different topic categories
- Date—reports going back to 1923 for 90 years' worth of content at your fingertips
- Issue Tracker—relevant reports on similar topics, making it easy to follow key topics through time
- Pro/Con—arguments typically written by leading experts, commissioned exclusively for CQ Researcher and organized by topic

"abortion"

Let's do a quick search on a topic. Let's search on "abortion," since it is consistently one of our top searches. The search result displays report titles and the topics that they fall under. Please note that our search results default to a relevancy display and not a date-ordered display. That's why "Roe v. Wade" is displayed as one of the first search results even though it was published in 1997. You can change the search function to a date-ordered display if you prefer.



You'll also note that some topics have a symbol next to them indicating that they are among the 20 hot topics listed on the home page.

CQ Researcher | User's Guide

Let's select a report and choose "Abortion Debates." Each report is roughly 13,000 words and broken into 13 sections. The sections are listed on the "left nav."



Reports begin with an Overview section, followed by three debate-style issue questions and then a Background section that provides historical context. Next is the Current Situation section, focusing on where the topic stands today, followed by a forward-looking Outlook section.

Search

Also notice the "Issue Tracker" which allows users to track reports published on a particular issue back to 1923.

Reports are extensively footnoted, providing students with online links to cited articles for additional research. Also, each report has a chronology showing the topic's progression through time. In this case, we can see that debates started as early as 1973.



Reports also include a bibliography, short sidebar features, plus visuals such as maps, graphs, and tables to help students delve deeply into issues.
