



FIXING THE BROKEN TEXTBOOK MARKET

- 65 percent of students surveyed reported skipping buying a textbook because of cost
- Students who reported not buying an access code increased from 17 percent in 2019 to 21 percent in 2020
- 79 percent of students reported being impacted in some way by the pandemic


- 10 percent of students reported not having reliable enough internet access to participate in remote classes
- 82 percent of students who reported missing a meal due to the pandemic also reported skipping buying textbooks due to cost



OER EFFORTS AT CPCC




Presentations to stakeholders Connecting with CTLE

Self-paced OER course available Summer 2021; OER Learning Commons in Fall 2021




OER SUCCESSES AT CPCC

ENG instructors put together a crowdsourced list of the top 20 most-wanted content items they wanted in an OER textbook using Google Sheets


Suggested Titles

 - Remixing and creating new open sources






Faculty Buy-In


