Updates from District 1 campuses include the following:

<u>Martin Community College</u>: The campus has recently welcomed a new foal as part of the Equine Program; three additional foals are expected in the coming weeks. The campus is looking forward to welcoming Ms. Lucy Bobeck as the new Library Director.

<u>Johnston Community College</u>: The campus has recently welcomed a new President, new Library Director, and new Technical Services Librarian. The Engineering Building that has been under construction is nearing completion. The library recently added five additional bicycle desks funded by a grant.

<u>Roanoke-Chowan Community College:</u> Library Director Carol Anne Hankinson had a question on the usefulness of JSTOR. She is currently in the process of reviewing library policies and procedures with the hope that they may be streamlined; examples of policies and procedures from other campuses to use as examples are welcomed.

Nash Community College: The recently advertised part-time, evening position has been filled by a Ms. Courtney Silver. There remains a vacant, unadvertised Library Specialist position. Library staff are currently working on their annual evaluations and have been asked to provide outreach to K—12 students which will include a summer reading program for children. Library Director Robert James took the campus's strategic plan and aligned it with what the library does to support the plan.
